

MISSION FIELD EXCEPTS

Kabwata Baptist Church (KBC) currently has eleven mission stations. In this newsletter, we report on selected activities from five church plants and two sister churches, which were formerly church plants.

ABUJA, NIGERIA



KBC's church plant in Abuja, Nigeria—Trinity Baptist Church—has now become autonomous following the constitution of its eldership. In the last quarter of the year, the church held the ordination of its first pastor, Pastor Abutu, as well as its deacons and its missionary pastor, Confidence Uriel Barineme. The new church plant is called Port Harcourt Community Church, and it held its first meeting on 7th December 2025.

HARARE, ZIMBABWE

Our church plant in Zimbabwe held a family conference themed "Walk by Faith: Trusting God's Plan for Our Lives." Our missionary, Pastor Joe Shoko, was one of the speakers. We rejoice that the gospel continues to spread.

KIGALI, RWANDA

KBC's two church plants in Rwanda are among those that have been stopped from meeting physically by the government. We thank God that, even under these conditions, the church has continued to meet underground and is experiencing a high number of conversions.

MONZE, ZAMBIA



The ordination of Moses Moyo as a missionary pastor to our church plant in Monze District, Zambia took place on 28th December 2025. For nearly two years, KBC has been sending preachers to Monze every Sunday. We thank God for the resources He has provided.

BUJUMBURA, BURUNDI

In the last quarter, KBC sent its first missionary pastor to Burundi. The church is called Redeemer Baptist Church. The church has been holding regular Sunday services as well as seminars, including couples' seminars, and other evangelistic outreach efforts.



NYIMBA, ZAMBIA

Our church plant in Nyimba, in the Eastern Province of Zambia, now has water available on the church premises. The district had been affected by a water shortage, and we thank God that there is now sufficient water at the church. In such communities, access to water also serves as a tool for evangelism.



LUSAKA, ZAMBIA



Hillview Baptist Church, now our sister church and formerly our church plant, recently held an ordination service for three missionary pastors. The church has also begun engaging in mission work.
